Internship Program:

Established an internship program to assist the Bakersfield metro community students acquire skills in broadcasting. During the reporting period, the station had two interns from Bakersfield College and California State University Bakersfield Fall semester of 2020 and Spring of 2021, learning and assisting in producing content and on-air shows.

Equal Employment Opportunity Training. On May 28, 2021, all managers attended a training regarding equal employment opportunity and preventing harassment, sexual harassment, hostile workenvironment and *quid pro quo*.

Sponsored Virtual Job Fair. Conducted a virtual job fair in the summer of 2020 which was promoted onthe station daily and through daily social media posts. The job fair had a dedicated web page where visitors were able to search for opportunities in specific markets and specific industries. Links were provided that allowed visitors to complete job applications online, as well as set up appointments for interviews via phone or video conference. Additional links were provided with tips on how to do well during the interview process, how to build a resume, and how to take precautions during the current pandemic.

Participated in Community Events

August – November, 2020 – KMYX and KBDS supported events promoting the Census, encouraged listeners to participate, and provided phone numbers to assist listeners with questions and form completion.

August – November - KMYX and KBDS participated in “Yo Aqui Cuento” events, promotional announcements, social media posts, and encouraged listeners to register to vote.

October 2020 – KMYX and KBDS participated in a Safe Halloween Community Event at the Brundage Swap Meet in Bakersfield. This event was supported through on-air promotional mentions, social media posts, and on-site station appearance.

November 2020 – KMYX and KBDS gave away free turkeys to support listeners struggling from the effects of COVID and the pandemic.

March 2021 - KMYX and KBDS participated in a two day “COVID-19 1st Dose Free Vaccination Event” at the 40 Acres in Delano CA in partnership with the UFW Foundation and Cesar Chavez Foundation. This event was supported through on-air promotional mentions, social media posts, and on-site station appearance both days. Hundreds of community residents received a free 1st dose vaccination.

March 2021 - KMYX and KBDS participated in a two day “2nd Dose Free Vaccination Event” at the 40 Acres in Delano CA in partnership with the UFW Foundation and Cesar Chavez Foundation. This event was supported through on-air promotional mentions, social media posts, and on-site station appearance both days. Hundreds of community residents received a free 2nd dose vaccination.

June 2021 - KMYX and KBDS participated in a free COVID-19 vaccination event at Govea Gardens in Bakersfield in partnership with the UFW Foundation and the Cesar Chavez Foundation. This event was supported through on-air promotional mentions, social media posts, and on-site station appearance. 68 community residents received a free COVID-19 vaccination.
